

Tutorial: Changing Desktop Wallpaper

1 - Find an area of your desktop without any icons, and right click the mouse to bring up this menu:



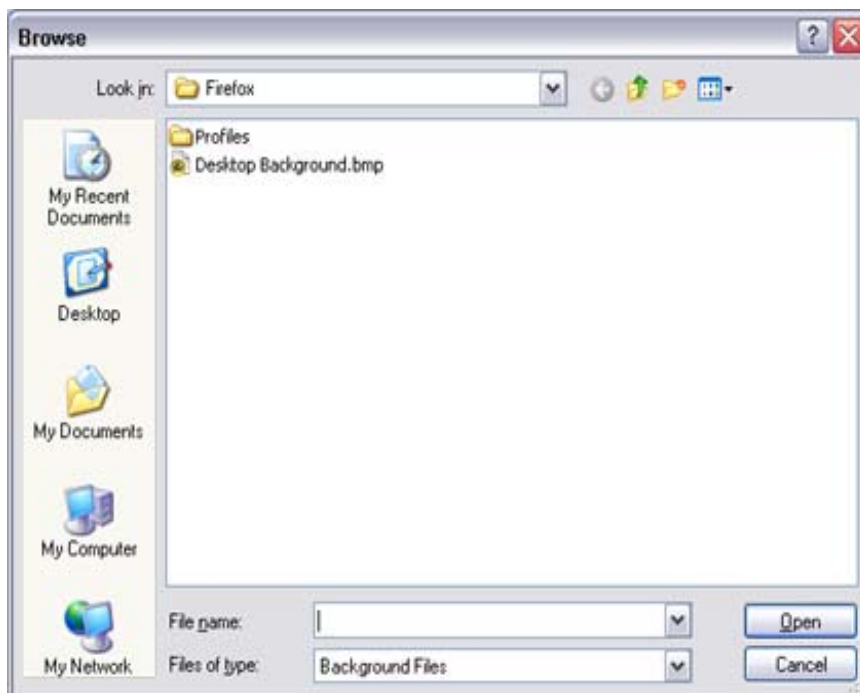
2 – Click on ‘Properties’ to bring up the ‘Display Properties’ window shown below:



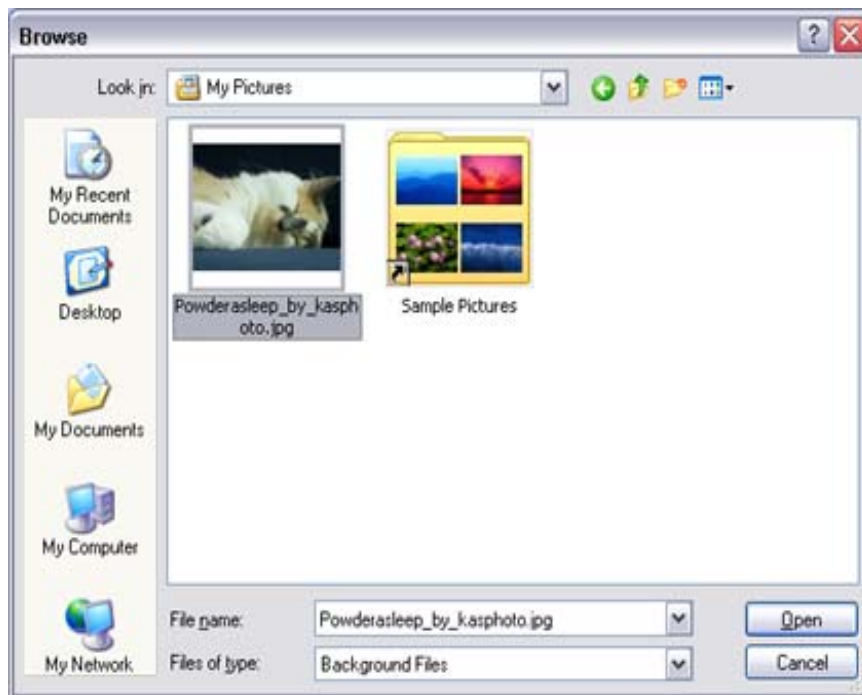
3 – Click on the 'Desktop' Tab at the top to access the following window:



4 – Scroll through the 'Background' menu and single click on the images to preview what they would look like. Alternatively to select your own picture click the 'browse' button to bring up this window:



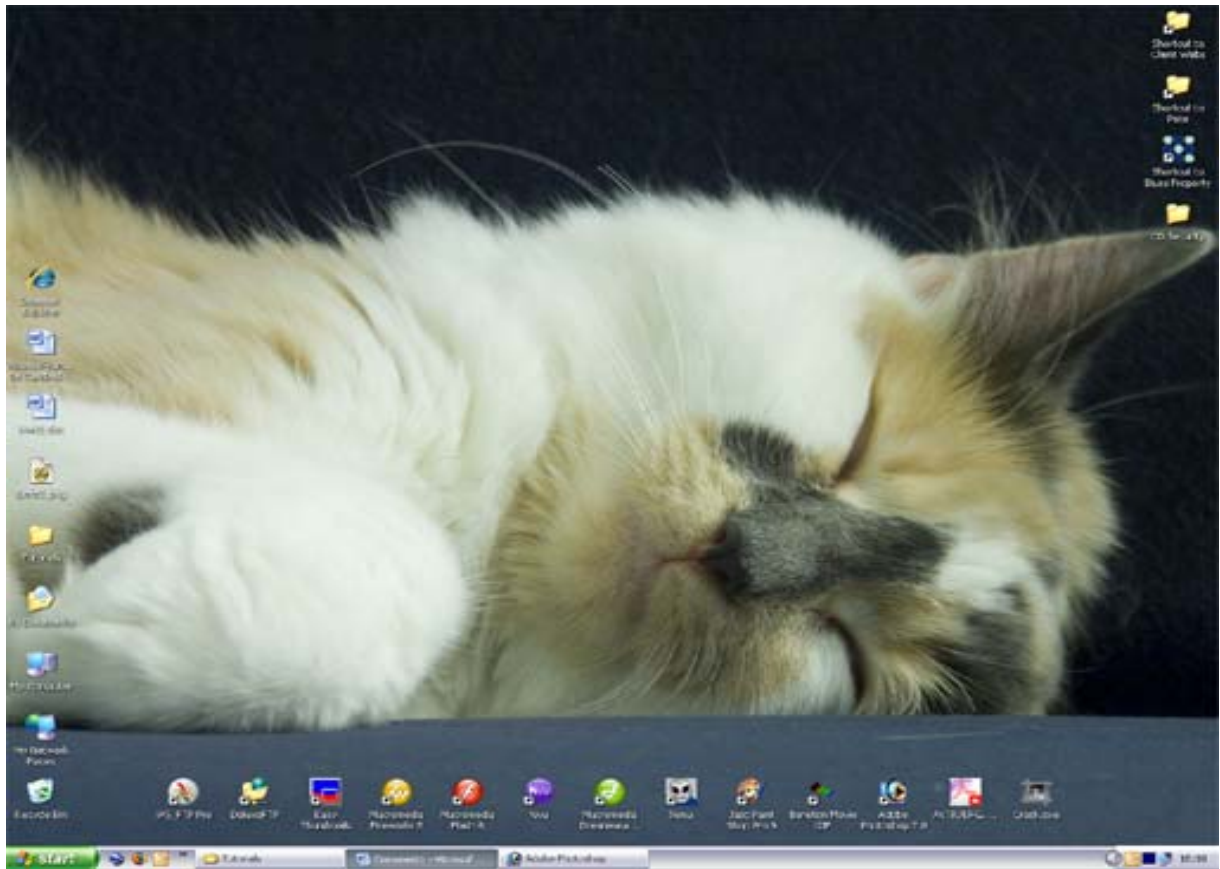
5 – Use the drop down menu next to the text ‘Look in:’ to navigate to the image file you want to use as a background, then select it and click ‘Open’:



6 – Your image will now be previewed for you in the display properties. If your image is not displayed properly, make sure ‘Stretch’ is selected in the ‘Position’ drop down menu:



7 - Once you are happy with your wallpaper preview, click 'OK'.



Your image will now be displayed as the Desktop Wallpaper.
